
Old Business:

Site visit at 118 Pike Street Tewksbury for the purpose of viewing the existing outdoor wood boiler/furnace.

Mr. Ascolio explained the operation of the outdoor wood burning boiler/furnace to the Board, and then proceeded to start the boiler. He explained that it maybe too warm to start boiler, it may need a couple more weeks and they feed the boiler once a day. He used brush to try and spark an excessive amount of smoke. He explained it could take up to 4 hours for the boiler to get to the required temperature. A lengthy discussion took place on various issues related to the boiler; it will smolder until the boiler reaches internal temperature of 195 degrees and/or heat is called for, stack height, relocation of unit, etc. Additionally, a discussion was held regarding a solution to co-exist with the neighborhood; prevent, control, etc.
